The ELT course is an introductory Methodology course suitable for people who have little or no teaching experience or training. This course offers students the opportunity to learn different theories and methods related to teaching English as a second-language as well as their application through practical experience and teaching students at different language levels and ages.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age: 18 years old
- Level of English: Minimum B2 (CEFR). You must hold one of the following certificates:
 - Cambridge B2 First (FCE): Grades A or B. Candidates with Grade C will have to pass an interview to verify their speaking skills are up to the course level
 - IELTS band 6.5 or above
 - Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE): Grades A, B or C
 - Cambridge C2 Proficiency (CPE): Grades A, B or C - If you don't hold any of the certificates above, you can sit a Placement Test. See "Registration" section for more detailed information.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

As the lessons will be delivered via ZOOM, it is necessary that participants have - good internet speed: at least 16 Mbps - a PC or laptop with microphone, camera and headphones or earphones. It is not allowed to take the lessons using a mobile phone (cell phone).

BOOKS

S/140 (material for the five cycles).

- Books can be purchased via Britanico's Intranet.
- Access will be given to a digital version of the book for the first 15 days.
- Books won't be delivered if you live out of Peru. In that case, you need to include an address inside the country where the material can be sent (only in the case of provinces in Peru a fee will be charged). If you do not include an address from Peru, access to the online material will be provided only.
- To collect the material, check the "Términos y Condiciones" section when you purchase the book.

WHAT DOES THE ELT COURSE OFFER?

- **Rich content:** The ELT course has a theoretical component, a practical component and a language development component.
- **Updated material:** We work with the book Essential Teacher Knowledge, written by the well-known expert Jeremy Harmer.
- **Highly-qualified tutors:** Our ELT tutors are considered the best teachers at the BRITANICO. They hold methodology and language certificates issued by Cambridge University and have received special training. Students will be closely monitored by their tutors, who will stay with them for the five cycles.
- **Preparation for the Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT):** At the end of the course, our students have covered all the topics that are evaluated in the TKT exam, administered by Cambridge University.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM PARTICIPANTS

- To be aware of the commitment involved in joining this course
- This course requires a lot more than attending classes and just going through the topics in the book. Participants will have to devote extra time (at least 1 hour per day) outside the classroom for reading and research. If they don't, the lessons and participants' performance are seriously affected as they do not have ideas to give contributions.
- Participants are expected to stay in the same schedule with the same teacher for the five cycles, so think about staying in the same schedule before making your decision.
- Regular attendance and punctuality in each cycle are needed to be considered as a course participant: students who do not complete the minimum hours of attendance required (13) will be considered FDA (Failed Due To Absences) and will not be allowed to enroll on the next cycle.
- Students who obtain grade D (below average) in two cycles will not be allowed to enroll on the next cycle and if they get grade D in the last two cycles (ELT 4 and ELT 5) or in the last cycle (ELT 5) they will not receive a Certificate.
- The Teaching Practice Sessions are sessions in which students give lessons to real students. These sessions take place in ELT 4 and ELT 5. The schedule for these sessions is different from the regular schedule of the lessons.

CERTIFICATION

Students who comply with the course requirements of attendance and performance (A, B or C) according to our assessment criteria will be awarded a certificate at the end of the course.

REGISTRATION

- Besides, you must send the scanned document + ID (or a clear photograph) to admissionconcertificado@britanico.edu.pe
- If you do not have the certifications needed, you can sit a placement test, which consists of two parts:
 - An interview: If you have studied at BRITANICO in the past, you must go to CAMPUS, click on "Venta Textos, Merch, Servicios" and then select: **Centro:** "Online". **Categoría:** "Exámenes". **Ítem de venta:** "Examen" (click on the magnifying glass), type "1" and tick the box to accept "Términos y Condiciones". Finally, click on "Reservar". The cost of the first part of the placement test (interview) is 20 soles.
 - If you obtain a satisfactory result, you will be contacted to sit an online written test. It is important to mention that the cost of the second part of the placement test (written test) is 15 soles.
 - Feedback on any of the exams is not provided. If results are not satisfactory, the candidate must wait 6 months before retaking the exam.
 - Taking part of the Placement process does not imply you can book a place.
 - The whole placement procedure is taken online. The tests will not be administered in our centres
