



C1 ADVANCED (CAE) exam practice

PARTIALLY ONLINE COURSE

Partially Online Courses are Web-enhanced with reduced classroom meetings and a significant amount of the course content presented via the Internet.

Research shows that partially online courses benefit students in their learning. Besides offering students increased flexibility in course work and course schedules, partially online courses help students be more prepared for in-class work and for assignments and exams.

This familiarisation course will give you all the **INFORMATION** you need about the University of Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE), **EXERCISES** to reinforce or test your English level, and effective **EXAM PRACTICE** so you won't have any doubts about the exam (scores, length, timing, etc.)

The materials are all delivered online (no need to buy a book) and are different from the ones used in the face-to-face sessions in the centres.

Please, read the following information **before registering**.

a) Course Objectives

- Help you prepare for taking C1 Advanced (CAE).
- Become familiar with the different parts of the exam.
- Practise with sample exam papers.
- Receive effective feedback from the course tutor.

IMPORTANT: *This isn't a phonetics or grammar course. If you are interested in these, BRITÁNICO offers:*

- CAE Preparatory Course which provides students with knowledge of English at an advanced level and prepares them for the C1 Advanced if they wish to take it.
- Special Courses such as "Sounds in Action", "Activating your Grammar" and "Conversation", to reinforce different skills (pronunciation, grammar and speaking respectively.)

b) Length of the Course

The course lasts **4 weeks** and is designed around **36 hours** of study.

Participants are expected to work for a minimum of 7 hours a week in order to benefit most from the course, but if they feel they need to dedicate more time to a specific paper/part they should feel free to do so with the extra material provided.

c) Enrolment Requirements

To join the course participants should:

- Be registered to take the C1 Advanced or preparing to sit the international exam.
- Have as a minimum a good upper-intermediate command of English.
- Have access to a PC or Mac with an Internet connection and a web browser.
- Have an email address.



d) Methodology

This course will be taught partially online, approximately 20 hours on the Internet through MEL and VEX Platform.

There will be 4 face-to-face sessions of 4 hours each (16 hours total) that will be held from 08:00am to 12:00m on the following dates:

- Saturday October 05th
- Saturday October 12th
- Saturday October 19th
- Saturday October 26th

e) Facilities

Participants will have free access to the San Isidro SAC and the British Library during the course.

f) Cost

The course has a cost of S/. 400 which includes the face-to-face sessions and access to both online platforms MEL and VEX.

g) Evaluation & Attendance

This course is for exam practice only, which aim is to help you get familiar with the formats of the different parts of the C1 Advanced and times, we are not giving you a Pass or Fail mark. However, during the course participants will receive feedback on their performance.

Attendance and participation will be controlled and participants who are absent to more than one (01) face-to-face session will be considered FDA (fail due to absences).
