



CAE Preparatory Course

For people interested in the course

The **CAE Preparatory Course** has been especially designed for people who want to sit the Cambridge C1 Advanced Exam (CAE) from Cambridge English Language Assessment. This course will extend your knowledge of the English language and at the same time provide you with the strategies necessary to enable you to take the CAE Exam. Please, read the following information carefully **before registering**.

a) **LENGTH OF THE COURSE**

The course consists of 5 cycles of 27 hours each, (classes of 1 ½ hours, from Monday to Friday). Ask reception for details.

b) **COURSE CONTENT**

The course will offer you guidance and exam training for the 4 Cambridge CAE Exam papers: **Reading and Use of English, Writing, Listening and Speaking**.

c) **REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERING FOR THE CAE COURSE**

- DNI or similar document with a photo will be required to identify candidates.
- Present your FCE Certificate or statement of result from Cambridge English Language Assessment.
- If you don't hold this Certificate, you will be requested to sit a **placement exam** to confirm your level of English.

d) **WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM CAE PARTICIPANTS**

- Full involvement of participants in the course. The course requires active participation and a lot more than just attending sessions.
- You need to work hard both inside and outside the classroom.
- Do the homework assigned by the tutor: Coursebook tasks, Workbook, exercises, readings, web site work, writing tasks, etc.
- Regular attendance and punctuality are vital.

e) **ATTENDANCE AND EVALUATION**

- All participants are expected to have **regular attendance for each CAE cycle in order to obtain a Final Mark** based on their performance at the end of each cycle.
- This means that students will be considered as **FDA** (Fail Due to Absences) and the cycle will be considered as incomplete if they are **do not complete the minimum of hours of attendance** during the cycle (19.5), but will still be permitted to continue studying in the next CAE cycle.
- Participants who fail two cycles (obtain grade D) **will not be allowed** to enrol on the next cycle.
- One tutor monitors students' performance during the whole course, so students are expected to stay in the same centre and the same schedule for the five months. Any special case/ situation will be evaluated by the administrative staff at centres.

f) **CERTIFICATION**

Certificates will be issued at the end of the course (CAE 5) to participants gaining an overall passing grade (A, B or C) based on their performance and who have complied with the **minimum attendance for each of the 5 cycles**.

Information about performance during the course will be recorded on the certificate.
